

Mt. Fuji 5th Station (Subaru Line)

5th Station is in the mountainside of Mt. Fuji (2,305m above sea level).

By a toll road called Subaru Line, visitors can have easy access to the station by bus or taxi.

From the 5th Station, beautiful view of the 5 lakes of Mt. Fuji, South Alps, Yatsugatake and Chichibu mountain district.

There are easy hiking courses such as Oniwa, Okuniwa and Ochudo.
